**BY ENTERING YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY AND FOLLOW ALL RULES.**

1. **Pre-Entries:** MUST be postmarked by November 1<sup>st</sup>.
2. **Text-In Entries:** Text-in entries will be open until November 10<sup>th</sup>. Payment will be paid through Credit Card payment with 5% fee applied. No payment, no entry.
3. **Entries:** Entries accepted the day of event until 12:00.
4. **Refund:** Full refund minus office fee will be granted before November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020. **After November 10<sup>th</sup> NO refunds will be made.**
5. **Draw:** Contestants MUST run horses in draw order. A failure to do this will result in a disqualification.
6. **Exhibitions:** Exhibitions can be reserved by text message before event or at the office the day of the event. 60 sec. time limit will be enforced. Exhibitions going over 60 sec. will be assessed a \$10 penalty.
7. **Timers:** Two electric timers will be used. Reruns will be given only in the event of a timer malfunction. If a rerun is given, it will be up to the show manager to decide when the rerun will take place. Reruns will not be given for horses falling, contestants' equipment breaking, or for a rider's decision to pull up.
8. **No Time:** Contestants will receive a no time for knocking over a barrel or breaking the pattern.
9. **Drags:** There will be a drag after every 5 runs. The big drag will be decided by the show manager after entries close.
10. **Disqualification:** Contestants must be ready when called. Failure to be ready will result in a disqualification. If a horse is ran out of order, it will be disqualified.
11. **Open Barrel Race:** 4D format ½ sec. split
12. **Youth 3D Barrel Race:** 2D format 1 sec. splits. 7 to 14 years of age as of Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> of current year. MUST designate if carrying over to the Open before entries close.
13. **Pewee Barrel Race:** 6 yrs and younger as of Jan 1<sup>st</sup> of current year. No office or late fee. Will run Saturday November 14<sup>th</sup> ONLY!
14. **Futurity Sidepot:** 2D format, ½ sec. split. For horses born in 2016 and 2017 (4 and 5 years of age). Horses must have not competed in any barrel racing events prior to Nov. 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Futurity horses will run in Open and carryover to sidepot. **Registration papers will be required with entry.**
15. **Derby Sidepot:** 2D format, ½ sec. split. For horses born in 2014 to 2016 (5 to 7 years of age). Derby horses will run in open and carryover to sidepot. **Registration papers will be required with entry.**
16. **Senior Sidepot:** 3D format ½ sec. split. Open for anyone 50+ as of Jan 1<sup>st</sup> of current year. Will run in open and carry over time to sidepot.
17. **Open Pole Bending:** 3D format 2D if less than 15 entries, full second splits. Will run Saturday November 13<sup>th</sup> ONLY!
18. **Zero Tolerance Policy:** Abuse includes but not limited to; excessive jerking, spurring, whipping, slapping, abuse with a device or any other act intended to cause trauma or injury to a horse. In show arena, practice pen, or on show grounds. Any accusations of abuse will be reviewed by show committee. Abusers will be asked to leave show grounds forfeiting any and all fees or winnings.
