



BY ENTERING YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY AND FOLLOW ALL RULES.

- 1. Online Entries:** Online entries will be Monday starting at 8:00 a.m. until Monday at 8:00 p.m. the week of the event. If a contestant chooses not to attend the event, the show manager must be notified BEFORE 5:00 PM the day of the event or the contestant will be responsible for paying their fees.
- 2. Entries:** Entries accepted the day of event until 5:15 PM. Registered names are required.
- 3. Release:** A release MUST be signed for Crook County Fairgrounds before competing. Failure to do so will result in disqualification & any entry fees occurred will not be refunded.
- 4. Draw & Run Order:** Draw will be done once entries close. Contestants MUST run horses in draw order. A failure to do this will result in a disqualification. Riders may not switch their horses' positions. Horses must run as they appear in the draw.
- 5. Exhibitions:** Exhibitions will be sold on a first come, first served basis. Online link will be available through the Adon Ranch Productions Facebook page. A 60 sec. time limit will be strictly enforced. Exhibitions going over 60 sec. will be assessed a \$10 penalty.
- 6. Timers:** Two electric timers will be used. Reruns will be given only in the event of a timer malfunction and all penalties from the original run will carry over. If a rerun is given, it will be up to the show manager to decide when the rerun will take place. Reruns will not be given for horses falling, contestants' equipment breaking, or for a rider's decision to pull up.
- 7. No Time:** Contestants will receive a no time for knocking over a barrel or breaking the pattern.
- 8. Drags:** There will be a drag after every 5 runs. The big drag will be decided by the show manager after entries close.
- 9. Disqualification:** Contestants must be ready when called. Failure to be ready will result in a disqualification. If a horse is ran out of order, it will be disqualified.
- 10. Open Barrel Race:** 4D format ½ sec. split
- 11. Combined Draw:** Junior Youth, Senior Youth & Open will all run in a combined draw in both the barrels & the pole bending.
- 12. Peewee:** 6 years of age or under. No office fee.
- 13. Junior Youth Barrel Race (7-12 yrs):** 2D format full sec. splits. 7-12 years of age as of Jan. 1st of current year. MUST designate if carrying over to the Open before entries close. If carrying over to open, contestant can only run one time.
- 14. Senior Youth Barrel Race (13-18 yrs):** 2D format full sec. splits. 13-18 years of age as of Jan. 1st of current year. MUST designate if carrying over to the Open before entries close. If carrying over to open, contestant can only run one time.
- 15. Futurity Sidepot:** 2D format, 1 sec. split. For horses born in 2019 and 2020. Horses must have not competed in any barrel racing events prior to Nov. 15, 2023. Futurity horses will run in Open and carryover to sidepot. Registration papers will be requested.
- 16. Senior Sidepot:** 3D format full second split. Open for anyone 50+ as of Jan 1st of current year. Will run in open and carry over time to sidepot.
- 17. Open Pole Bending:** 2D format if less than 15 entries, 3D format if more than 15 entries, full second splits.
- 18. Junior Youth Poles (0-7yrs):** 1D format. 0-7 years of age as of Jan. 1st of current year. MUST designate if carrying over to Open before Entries close. If carrying over to open, contestant can only run one time.
- 19. Senior Youth Poles (8-14 yrs):** 1D format. 8-12 years of age as of Jan. 1st of current year. MUST designate if carrying over to Open before entries close. If carrying over to open, contestant can only run one time.

- 20. Dogs:** All dogs must be on a leash. We also ask that you clean up after them. If show manager determines your dog is causing trouble to other contestants you will be asked to take the dog to your trailer.
- 21. Stalls:** A limited number of stalls will be available, as well as camping. Please contact Jasmyne at the Crook County Fairgrounds for more information (307)283-2644.
- 22. Zero Tolerance Policy:** Abuse includes but not limited to; excessive jerking, spurring, whipping, slapping, abuse with a device or any other act intended to cause trauma or injury to a horse. In show arena, practice pen, or on show grounds. Any accusations of abuse will be reviewed by show committee. Abusers will be asked to leave show grounds forfeiting any and all fees or winnings. Contestants will also be responsible for traveling partners and family members.
- 23.** Adon Ranch Productions reserves the right to refuse any entry, draw out contestants at any time, at their discretion with or without notifying the contestant or horse owner ahead of time.
- 24.** Adon Ranch Productions reserves the right to alter, change and modify these rules at any time. If a disagreement arises, Adon Ranch Productions holds the right to the final decision.
