



- 1. By entering** all contestants agree to abide by and follow all rules.
- 2. Draw Out:** Full refund minus office fee will be granted until April 5th at NOON. After this deadline, NO refunds will be issued.
- 3. Substitutions:** Substitution deadline is April 9th @ 12:00 PM. You may substitute horse or rider, but NOT both. \$10 substitution fee will be applied to each edit.
- 4. Run Order:** Contestants MUST run horses in draw order. A failure to do this will result in a disqualification. Riders may not switch their horses' positions. Horses must run as they appear in the draw.
- 5. Exhibitions:** Exhibitions will be sold on a first come first serve basis. Online link will be available on Adon Ranch Productions website. A 60 sec. time limit will be enforced. Exhibitions going over 60 sec. will be assessed a \$10 penalty.
- 6. Timers:** Two electric timers will be used. Reruns will be given only in the event of a timer malfunction and all penalties from the original run will carry over. If a rerun is given, it will be up to the show manager to decide when the rerun will take place. Reruns will not be given for horses falling, contestants' equipment breaking, or for a rider's decision to pull up.
- 8. Drags:** There will be a drag after every 5 runs. The big drag will be decided by the show manager after entries close.
- 9. Disqualification:** Contestants must be ready when called. Failure to be ready will result in a disqualification. If a horse is ran out of order, it will be disqualified no excuses.
- 10. Open 3D Poles:** \$200 added \$35 entry fee. 3D format; full second split. A tipped pole will receive a 5 second penalty. Prizes awarded.
- 11. 2D Pole Futurity: \$100 added** open to any horses foaled in 2020 or 2021 (4 and 5 years of age). To be eligible for the pole futurity, the horse cannot have ever competed in any pole bending prior to Nov. 13<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
  - Nomination Fees:** \$45 postmarked by March 24<sup>th</sup> or online by April 4<sup>th</sup>. Payments after April 4<sup>th</sup> will incur a \$15 late fee. Late entries will be taken day of event.
  - Will be ran** as a 2D with a 1.5 sec. split. Will be a sidepot to the Open Pole Bending. Horse and rider must be entered in the Open 3D Pole Bending to compete in Pole futurity. Pole Futurity is 1 go round with prizes awarded. A tipped pole will be a five second penalty.
- 12. 2D Futurity: \$1,500 added** Open to any horses foaled in 2020 or 2021 (4 and 5 years of age). Horse must have not competed in any barrel racing events prior to Nov. 13<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
  - Nomination Fees:** \$150 postmarked by March 24<sup>th</sup> or online by April 4<sup>th</sup>. Payments after April 4<sup>th</sup> will incur a \$25 late fee. Late entries will be taken until the conclusion of contestant check in.
  - Will be ran** as a 2D with a 1 sec. split. Will be two go-rounds and average. The first round will be drawn, the second round will be reverse order. Prizes will be awarded on average. A tipped barrel will receive a five second penalty.
- 13. Homegrown Futurity:** Prizes only. MUST designate status on entry form. Breeder on horse's papers MUST be rider, company owned by rider (i.e.; Adon Ranch Quarter Horses, Lexi Bauder), or an immediate family member to rider (husband/wife, mom/dad).
- 14. Kcross Logan Lane Amateur Futurity: \$45 Entry Fee** \$100 added Payout to rounds, prizes to average. An "amateur" entry is a rider who has not won over \$500 in 1D futurity money prior to

November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Must designate on entry form, any entry form not marked is considered a “no”. Amateur may be asked to verify amateur status.

**15. 2D Derby/Maturity: \$1,000 added** Open to any horses foaled from 2017 to 2020 (5 to 8 years of age), as well as any horse that has been 100% paid up in a previous TRP Money Run after 2018. Horses are not allowed to enter futurity or derby/maturity in the same year.

**Nomination fees:** \$100 postmarked by March 24<sup>th</sup> or online by April 4<sup>th</sup>. Payments after April 4<sup>th</sup> will incur a \$25 late fee. Late entries will be taken until the conclusion of contestant check-in.

**Will be ran** as a 2D with 0.75 split. Will be two go-rounds and average. The first round will be drawn, the second round will be reverse order. Prizes will be awarded on average. A tipped barrel will receive a five second penalty.

**16. Contestant check in:** All futurity and derby/maturity contestants MUST be check in by 11AM April 12<sup>th</sup>.

**17. Open Barrel Race:** \$3,000 added \$55 entry fee per day. 4D format ½ sec. split. Separate payout both days, prizes awarded to average. A tipped barrel will be considered a no time.

**18. 3D Youth Barrel Race:** 3D format 1 sec. splits. 15 years of age or younger as of Jan. 1st of current year. All youth will run with together in the Open Draw. You MUST designate if carrying over to the Open before entries close. A tipped barrel will result in a no time. Separate payout both days, awards on average.

**19. Peewee Barrel Race:** 7 yrs and younger as of Jan 1st of current year. No office or late fee. Will run Saturday ONLY.

**20. Senior Sidepot:** 3D format ½ sec. split. Open for anyone 50+ as of Jan 1st of current year. Will run in open and carry over time to sidepot. A tipped barrel will result in a no time. Separate payout both days, awards on average.

**21. Carryovers:** Horses running in the futurity, derby/maturity or youth may carryover to Open 4D Saturday and Sunday. Rider MUST designate before their run if planning on carrying time to open. At the discretion of the committee, any missed carryovers that are NOT reported to the entry office by the end of the race may be refunded their carryover fee but will not be issued any winnings or figured into the final results.

**22. Registration Papers:** Futurity and Derby/Maturity entries must be accompanied with a photo copy of horse's registration papers or veterinarian's affidavit.

**23. Dogs:** All dogs must be on a leash. We also ask you clean up after them.

**24. Full Dress Code:** Long sleeve shirt (no collar required), boots, and cowboy hat or helmet are to be worn during competition.

**25. Zero Tolerance Policy:** Abuse includes but not limited to; excessive jerking, spurring, whipping, slapping, abuse with a device or any other act intended to cause trauma or injury to a horse. In show arena, practice pen, or on show grounds. Any accusations of abuse will be reviewed by show committee. Abusers will be asked to leave show grounds forfeiting any and all fees or winnings. Contestants will also be responsible for traveling partners and family members.

26. Adon Ranch Productions reserves the right to refuse any entry, draw out contestants at any time, at their discretion with or without notifying the contestant or horse owner ahead of time.

27. Adon Ranch Productions reserves the right to alter, change and modify these rules at any time. If a disagreement arises, Adon Ranch Productions holds the right to the final decision.
