Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.

• Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)

- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
- Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding, later.

- 1. DRESS CODE: Cowboy hat or helmet, long-sleeved shirt, pants and boots are required.
- 2. Refund: Full refund minus office fee will be granted before March 4th, 2022. After March 4th NO refunds will be made.
- 3. Pre-Draw: Will be posted online by March 10th.
- 4. Late Entries: Will be accepted- see schedule for closing times. Late entries are subject to late fees.
- 5. Exhibitions: 60 sec. time limit. Exhibitions going over 60 sec. will be assessed a \$10 penalty. Reservations can be made by mail in form with payment or at show office. Reservations are non-refundable. Once exhibitions are purchased, it's your responsibility if you want to trade or sell your reservations.
- 6. No Time: Contestants will receive a no time for knocking a barrel over or breaking the pattern.
- 7. Timers: Two electric timers will be used. Reruns will be given only in the event of a timer malfunction. If a rerun is given, it will be up to show manager to decide when the rerun will take place. Reruns will not be given for horses falling, contestant's equipment breaking or for a rider's decision to pull up.
- 8. Drags: There will be a drag after every 5 numbers and a big drag at 50.
- 9. Disqualification: Contestants must be ready when called. Failure to be in position in the holding area will result in a disqualification. Contestants must be in holding pen during your drag. If a horse is ran out of order, it will be disqualified.
- 10. Open Barrel Race: 4D Format ½ sec. split
- 11. Carryovers: Times from Futurity and Maturity/Derby may be carried into the Open. Carryover entries must be submitted and paid for prior to the beginning of the actual run. Rider is responsible for checking their carryover entry and notifying the office of any missed entry or changes. At the discretion of the committee, any missed carryovers that are NOT reported to the office by the end of the race may be refunded their carryover fee but will not be issued any winnings or figured into the final results.
- 12. Average prizes: prizes will be awarded on 2 run average.
- 13. Youth Barrel Race: 3D Format, Full second split. 8-14 years old as of January 1st of current year. Youth can run in just the youth or run in both youth and open (running twice in one day) or run in the Youth and carry time into the Open (this is one run with the youth fee and open fee. Time in youth race will get carried into the open.) MUST designate before Youth race starts.
- 14. PeeWee Barrel Race: 7 years and younger as of Jan. 1st of current year. Will run Saturday March 12th only. Buckle will be awarded to the winner of the PeeWee. In order to win buckle, PeeWee may not be assisted. No late or office fees.
- 15. Senior Sidepot: 3D format ½ second split. Open for anyone 50+ as of Jan 1st of current year. Will run in open and carry over time to sidepot.
- 16. Open Poles: 3D format, full second splits.
- 17. Zero Tolerance Policy: abuse includes but not limited to excessive jerking, spurring, whipping, slapping, abuse with a device or any other act intended to cause trauma or injury to horse. In show arena, practice pen, or on show grounds. Any accusations of abuse will be reviewed by show committee. Abusers will be asked to leave show grounds forfeiting any and all fees or winnings.
